The conjunctions 'but', 'yet', 'however', 'even though', 'instead', 'by contrast', 'on the other hand', 'on the contrary' signify contrasting or contradictory information.

This is going to be of use to Edexcel students as they do their 'narrative analysis', and especially important for AQA students as they do the 'which was the more important reason' question.
